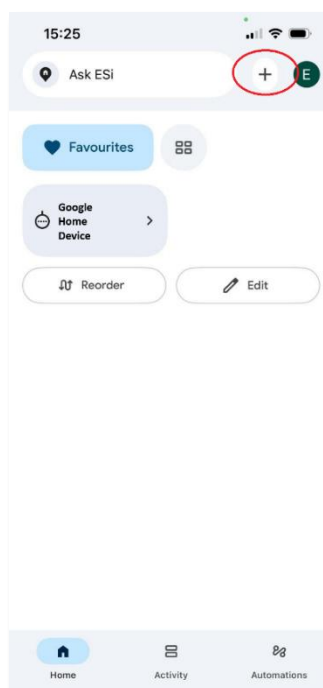


Connecting To Google Home

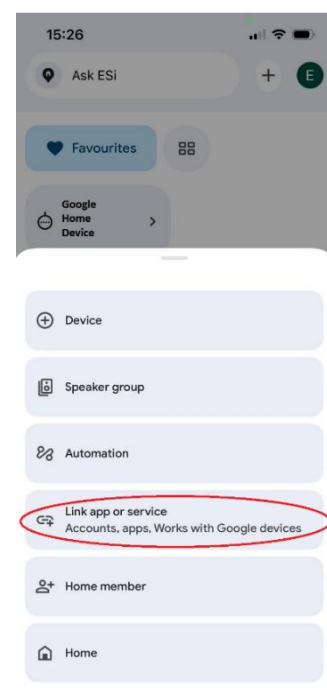
The Google Home app, when downloaded to your mobile phone or tablet can communicate with your ESi Centro app, allowing you to control your ESi Wi-Fi room thermostats or Wi-Fi Hub with voice commands to your Google Home app.

You must have a Google email address (Gmail) and the Google Home app downloaded to your mobile phone or tablet and connected to a Google Home device.

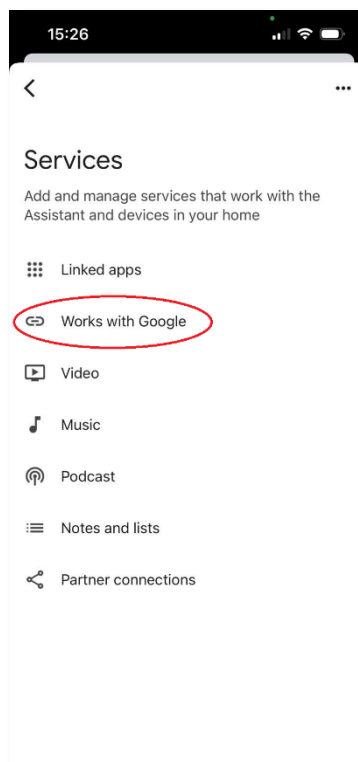
Once you have set up your Google Home device with your Google Home app, follow the steps below to enable you to use voice commands to control your room thermostat.



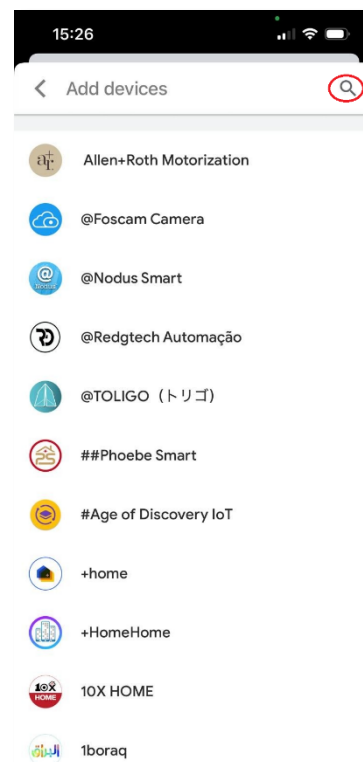
On your Google Home app, tap the '+' at the top of the screen.



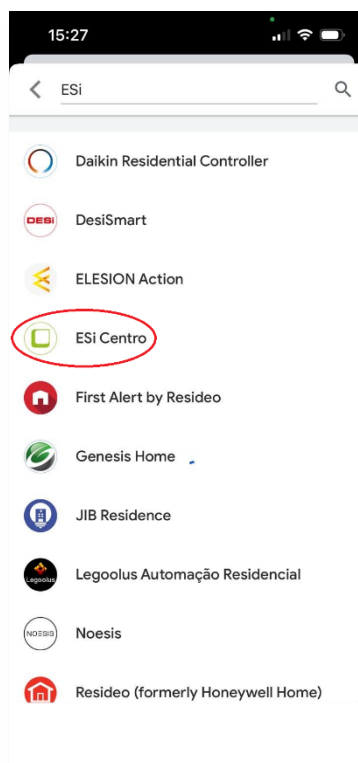
On the next page, select 'Link app or service'.



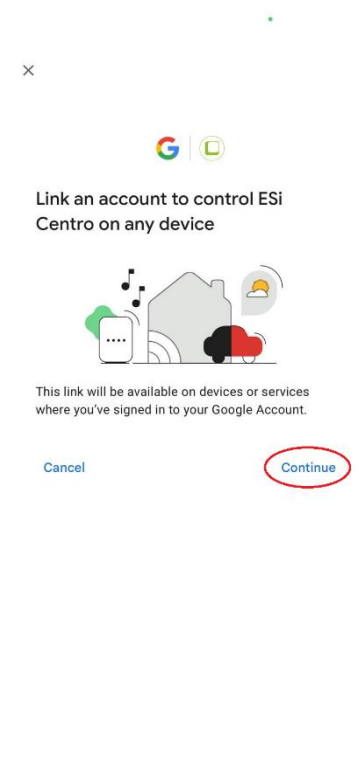
Select '**Works with Google**'.



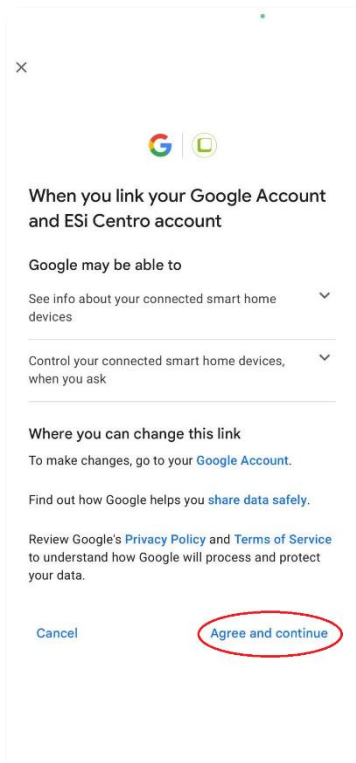
At the top of the page, select the **Search** icon.



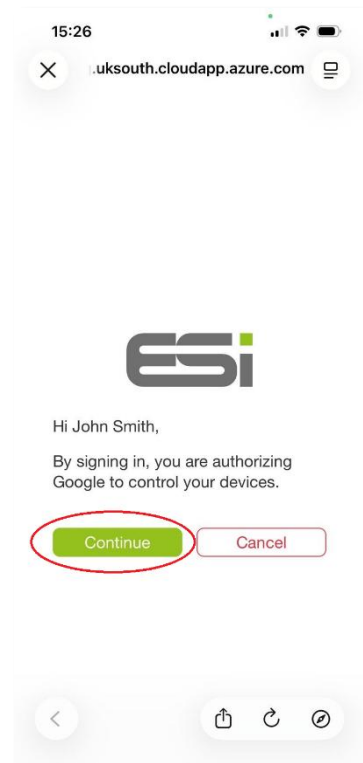
Type **ESi** into the search bar. You should see **ESi Centro** appear in the list of products. Select **ESi Centro**.



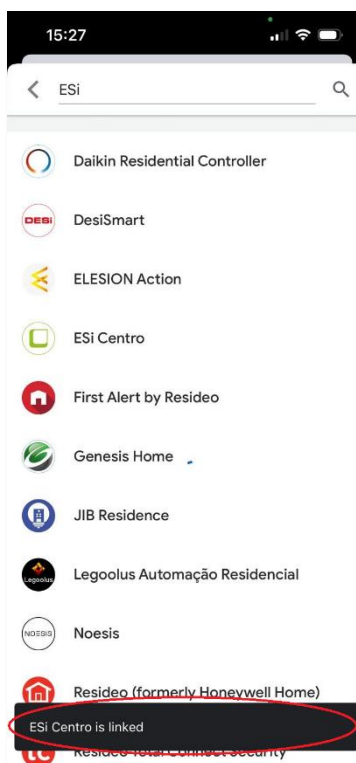
On the next page, tap '**Continue**'.



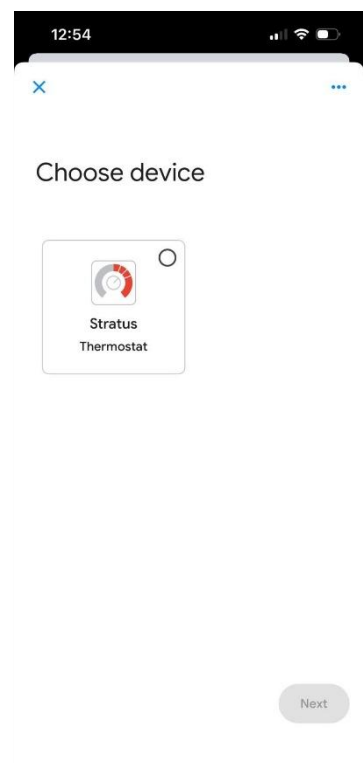
Select **'Agree and continue'**.



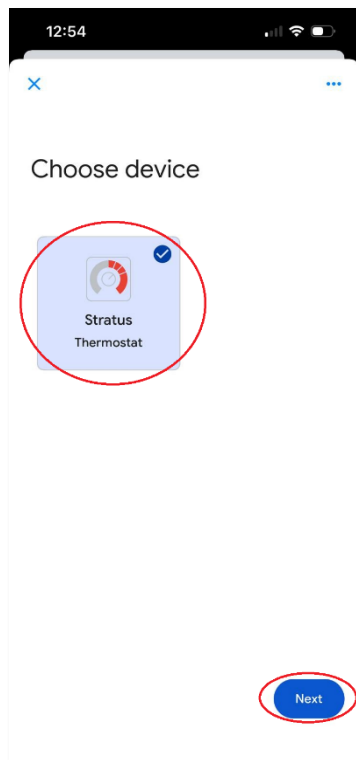
Tap **'Continue'** on the next page.



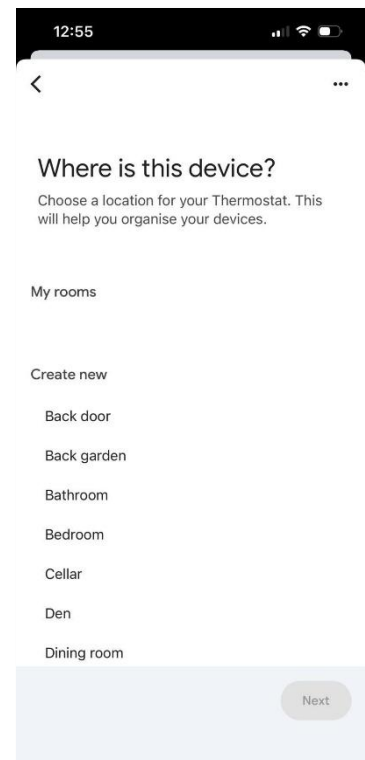
You will see a notification when your ESi Centro app is linked



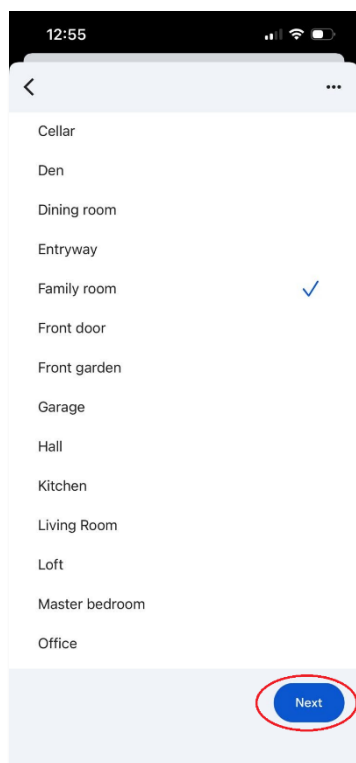
The next page will show all device which are present on your ESi Centro app.



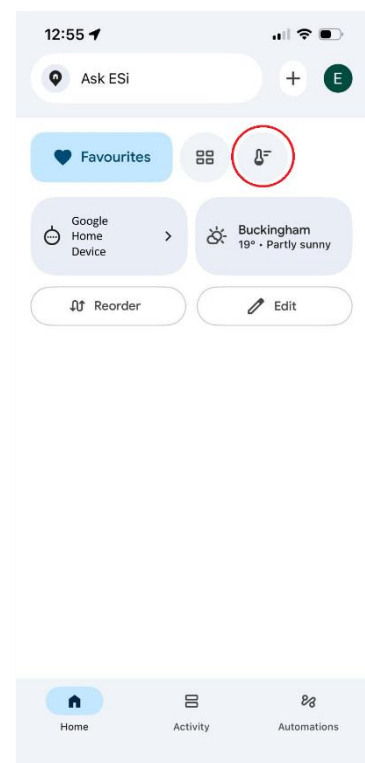
Choose your thermostat & select **'Next'**.



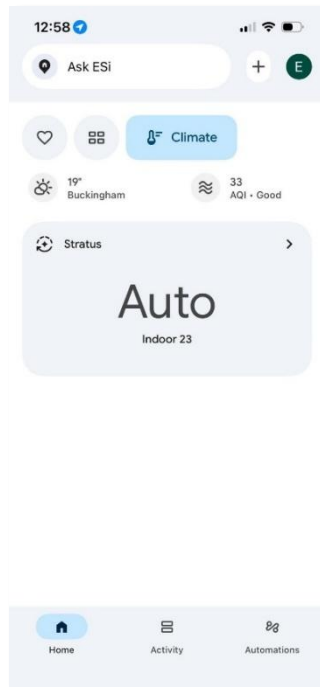
A list of locations will show.



Select the room your thermostat is situated and press **'Next'**.



Your Google Home app will return to its main page which will have a thermostat icon attached to it.



Tap on the thermostat icon to open your thermostat interface. Not all of the ESi Centro options will be available using the Google Home app, however, you will be able to use voice commands with your Google Home Device.
